Scope

This policy applies to all Mornington Life Saving Club representatives, including members, staff, contractors, and those representing the Club online.

Roles & Responsibilities

Mornington Life Saving Club Board: Oversee policy content, communication, enforcement and review

Mornington Life Saving Club Member Protection Officer: Manage breaches, complaints and reporting.

Mornington Life Saving Club Members: Uphold this policy and report concerns immediately

Core Commitments

Promote respect, dignity, inclusion, and ethical behaviour. Protect health, safety, and well-being of all members, including children and young people.

Prohibited Conduct

Includes harassment, bullying, discrimination, abuse (emotional, physical, sexual), cyberbullying, sexual misconduct, substance-related misconduct, and breaches of legal obligations.

Compliance & Reporting

Provides mechanisms for reporting breaches, including complaints handling frameworks, referrals to law enforcement for criminal matters, and internal disciplinary processes.
